MAXIMIZE YOUR CALFRESH FOOD BENEFITS USING MEDICAL DEDUCTIONS!

Who can qualify for the Medical Expense deduction?

At least one individual in the household is elderly (60 or older) or disabled*

By providing proof that you have paid \$35 or more towards any of these items listed below, your CalFresh allotment amount may increase.

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| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medicare premium • Medi-Cal Share of Cost (SOC) Medical or Dental care • Prescribed medication • Prescribed over the counter medications • Hospitalization or outpatient treatment/ nursing care • Health and hospitalization insurance policy premiums • Prescribed eye glasses or contact lenses • Dentures, hearing aids and prosthetics | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Prescribed medical supplies and equipment • Maintaining an attendant necessary due to age, illness, or infirmity • Service animals (i.e. seeing eye or hearing dog) expenses (food, vet bills, etc.) • Cost of transportation (mileage or fee) for treatment or services • The number and cost of meals furnished to an attendant • Cost of lodging to obtain medical treatment or services |
